Financial Aid is ANY aid you are receiving from the college which includes loans, scholarships, and grants.

FALL 2025 ONLY - Below are details about the Financial Aid Deferment Process. Please read this document slowly and carefully. **TCNJ does not share information with Campus Town and they DO NOT transfer money to us.**

Step 1:

TCNJ will post your Fall 2025 invoice on **Tuesday**, **July 29th**.



Step 2:

You will need to submit the Financial Aid Request (on the Campus Town Portal) with the TCNJ Invoice before **4PM on Thursday**, **July 31.**



Step 3:

We will reach out to you if you have been **APPROVED** for Rent Deferment or if you have been **DENIED**. If you have been denied, you must make a payment, by established due dates.

Step 4:

Here is how you submit a Financial Aid Deferment Request:

• Use your Campus Town log in credentials via this link:

https://campustown.starrezhousing.com/StarRezPortalX

- Once logged in, you can click on "Request" in the blue navigation bar
- Your request will be then reviewed and you will receive an email with a decision
- If someone else is doing this request on your behalf, please make sure you provide them with your Campus Town log-in credentials
- Please note, that a request does not guarantee that you will be deferred




Here are a few examples of what we are NOT looking for.



We are **NOT** able to accept Loan Applications or screen shots of "Congratulations You've been Accepted".






If there is a positive balance or just the number 0, this means you are not receiving any aid to apply to rent. We would NOT be able to defer. See above example. defined open date period to submit your request.

Here is an Example of what we are looking for:

If there is a negative balance, that means you are receiving a refund. Please note, that we are looking to see if your refund is covering 100% of the semester rent or a significant amount of the rent (50% or more).



For your reference below, here are the semester rates per person.

Here is how you access your TCNJ Invoice

- Log onto your TCNJ Paws account for semester invoice.
- Go to Main Menu-Student Self Service
- Then select Campus Finance and View Bill
- We need a PDF version of your TCNJ Invoice
- YOU MUST submit your TCNJ invoice that reflects your financial aid/scholarship.

Financial Aid Policy

ONLY submit this request if you are asking for Campus Town to defer your semester rent payment, since you are waiting for your Financial Aid Refund check to cover your rent.

Each semester a resident must submit a new request for Financial Aid Deferment with Campus Town.

Your Financial Aid arrangements are between you and TCNJ. The college does NOT communicate with the Campus Town Leasing Office.

This is a request for Campus Town to review your TCNJ Financial Aid document(s) to see if they cover 100% of your rent or a significant amount of your rent to defer the payment. We will review your request, your supporting document(s)/TCNJ Semester Invoice, and then we will email you with a decision.

PLEASE BE AWARE- your rent payment is deferred until our established due dates (November 1 for Fall and March 15 for Spring). Regardless if you have received your refund check, you must pay RENT in full by the established due dates to avoid LATE FEES and legal action.

Failure to submit Campus Town Financial Aid Deferment Request by the established due dates will incur Late fees of the initial \$50.00 late fee and then the daily Late Fee of \$5.00 as outlined in the lease agreement.

Resident is responsible for depositing their Financial Aid/Scholarship refund in their personal bank account and then making a payment directly to Campus Town on any remaining balance within 10 business days of the refund disbursement date or by the established due dates (November 1st for Fall or March 15th for Spring), whichever comes first. **TCNJ DOES NOT SEND ANY MONEY to the Campus Town Leasing Office.**
